ENROLLMENT

Students enroll in courses through Pathway. New students are eligible to enroll in classes during open registration—this begins in January for the summer semesters. Specific dates for open registration are available in the academic calendar (<https://www.umkc.edu/registrar/registration/registration-dates.html>). Please pay close attention to the last day for tuition return.

Students may access their enrollment date information through Pathway 2-3 weeks before registration.

Students are encouraged to enroll in classes earlier to secure their seat and avoid late fees. Late enrollment may also delay graduation. Consult your plan of study to determine which courses you should enroll in for the upcoming semester. If you would like to make a change to your plan of study, consult your advisor first (nurses@umkc.edu).

How to find RN-BSN Sections

Some courses will have multiple sections. In this case, it's important that you enroll in the course that specifically notes that it is for students in the RN-BSN program.

1. Log on to Pathway.
2. Click on "Self Service."
3. Click on "Class Search/Browse Catalog."
4. Select the term and subject from the drop-down menus and type in the course number. Click on "Search."
5. If there are multiple sections of a course, like in the example below, click on the class number (highlighted below) for more details about the course.

How to Enroll in Courses through Pathway

1. Log on to Pathway.
2. Click on "Self Service."
3. Click on "Student Center."
4. Click on "Add a Class."
5. You can search for the course using the "Class Search" feature. If you already know the class number, type it into the "Class Number" box.
6. When you find the course you want, click the yellow "Select Class" button.
7. Check the Enrollment Information and Class Notes to confirm that you are adding the correct section. Some courses may have multiple sections. If so, you should add the course that is for RN-BSN students.
8. Click the yellow "Next" button.
9. The class has now been added to your enrollment shopping cart. Continue to add classes to your cart until you have all the courses you want for the semester.
10. Verify your selections and then click the yellow "Proceed to Step 2 of 3" button.

11. Confirm your classes and then select the yellow “Finish Enrolling” button.

NOTE: You may have an advising hold on your account. These are placed automatically every semester. If you have this hold, please email (nurses@umkc.edu) to have it removed.

For all other holds, please contact the office that placed the hold for more information.

How to Print Your Booklist

1. Go to one of the bookstore websites.
2. Click on “Textbooks & School Supplies” tab at the top.
3. A menu will open. Click on “Print Your Book List.”
4. Select the appropriate term from the dropdown list and then click “View Booklist.”

5. Your book list will show on the next page. If you haven't enrolled in classes yet, use the method below to find your books.

How to Find Textbooks

1. Go to the appropriate bookstore's website.
2. Click on "Textbooks & School Supplies" tab at the top.
3. A menu will open. Click on "Shop & Compare."
4. Read the information on the page. Click on "agree" to continue.
5. Select your courses using the form. This page requires the term/semester, department, course, and section. This information is available in Pathway.
6. Read the information on the page. Click "Begin Price Comparison" to continue.
7. The next page will show the books/materials for the course and options for purchasing.

NOTE: Do not rent the required books for N481. These books will be used in future courses.

Be aware that if you receive an email that you are being dropped from a course for non-payment that you will still receive a bill in the future. Please contact the Cashier's Office for more information at 816.235.1365.
