PLEASE NOTE:

The following list of available student scholarships is current as of September 8, 2017 and is subject to change based upon scholarship availability, donor criteria preference or award amount. This document will be updated regularly to reflect any additions or deletions to this list. An application must be completed prior to selection.

Unless otherwise directed by the donor, funds are awarded without regard to race, color, national origin, ancestry, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, gender expression, age, genetic information, disability or protected veteran status. Students are not eligible if found to be in violation of the School of Nursing and Health Studies honor code or on academic probation.

PROCESS:

1. Students must apply for financial aid by submitting the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) <http://sonhs.umkc.edu/affordability/financial-aid/>) for the current year.
2. Total financial need and unmet financial need, as determined and reported by the Financial Aid Office, are the first criteria considered for unrestricted scholarship funds.
3. Application is submitted electronically at <https://php2.umkc.edu/intapps/redcap/surveys/?s=WDEFWATHKW>
4. Be prepared to submit, name, address and contact information; enrollment status, professional, community extracurricular involvement and leadership activities; and response to two brief essay questions.

The application will close **Thursday, September 25 28, 2017 by 4:00 p.m.**

5. All completed applications, including FAFSA application, must be submitted by this date and time.
6. If selected, students will have 14 business days to respond and accept the award. Awards not accepted by students within the designated time frame will be offered to alternates.
7. Each student must include a thank you letter to be given to the donor prior to awarding of funds.
