These are just suggested collateral courses. There are other courses which you may take. All collateral courses must be approved by your chair and your committee, prior to taking. Also if the courses are taken outside of the UMKC system they must be approved by the Academic Advisor and/or Register's office prior to taking to be assured you will receive credit for them.

If you are receiving Nurse Faculty Loan Program funding, you are required to take six credit hours of nursing education credits. These six hours are in addition to the required number of credits for this program. If you are doing research with an education focus, and you have the required approval, these courses may be acceptable as a collateral. If not doing educationally focused research, then six additional nursing education credit hours will be required.
